Eligibility

A person is eligible for this position provided they are:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment, and
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

Term of Employment:

- June 27th to August 21st, 2024
- 8 weeks at 35 hours per week
- \$ 15.70 per hour
- Weekdays, weekends, and holidays are required

Job Description – Museum Interpreter

- Greet visitors and collect admission fees.
- Guide visitors on a tour of the Ottawa House By-the-Sea Museum
- Collect and maintain visitor statistics
- Assist with the planning and implementation of events at Ottawa House By-the-Sea Museum
- Support the work of museum volunteers.
- Deliver museum interpretative programs to guests
- Work as part of the staff team to complete general operational duties such as light cleaning, coffee and ice cream service, merchandise sales and cash handling.
- Other duties as assigned.
